

## Continental Arms Range Rules and Operating Procedures

- All persons entering the facility MUST check in at the front desk: **Photo ID required.**
- All firearms entering the facility MUST be unloaded, **to include magazines/speedloaders, and cased.** CCW permit holders MUST inform the Range Officer (RO) at the front desk, if carrying. **All firearms and ammunition** are subject to inspection by range personnel.
- Any person who **appears to be under the influence** of alcohol, narcotics or medicinal drugs will **not** be permitted in the range area. **No one under 10 years of age** will be permitted in the range at any time. **People under 21 must be under the direct supervision of a Firearms experienced parent or a co-signed Firearms experienced guardian at all times.**
- **WARNING: Pregnant women will not be allowed in the range area for health reasons.**
- **YOU MUST BE OVER 21 TO RENT OR BUY A FIREARM AND AMMUNITION.**
- **HEARING AND EYE PROTECTION ARE REQUIRED TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE RANGE.**
- **Note: You are under video surveillance at all times while on the range.**
- **Firearms permitted in the range:** **HANDGUNS:** Any handgun of a caliber up to and including .44 magnums. 50 Action Express and 454 Casull will be allowed at range officers' discretion. Specialty pistols firing rifle cartridges are not permitted. S&W 500 and 460 are **not** permitted. **RIFLES:** Any rifle firing a handgun cartridge such as: .22 Rimfire, 9mm, .357 Mag, .30 Cal, .44 Mag, .45 Colt, etc. **NOTE: High-powered rifles are not permitted!** **SHOTGUNS:** Any shotgun up to and including 12 ga. Shotguns **MUST** be equipped with a shoulder stock, and **fired** from the shoulder **ONLY**. Shotgun ammunition is limited to **OO** or **OOO** Buckshot. **NOTHING ELSE!!** Shotgun shooters must be over 18 yrs of age. Shooters must also use a large silhouette type target. **FULLY AUTOMATIC FIREARMS:** Fully automatic firearms may only be used with the specific approval of the Range Officer on duty whose decision is final. All Federal paperwork **must** be presented with the firearm. If permitted by the RO, firing is then limited to bursts of 3 rounds **maximum**. See further detailed information.
- Ammunition used in the range MUST be lead, lead alloy, or copper jacketed lead. No other type of ammunition is permitted (tracers, exploding target loads, pistol shot-shells, steel cored, tactical, etc.).
- Range Officer commands MUST be obeyed immediately. This is for the Safety of all.
- Firearms in use must be kept on the tabletop with the muzzle pointed downrange **at all times**.
- Firearms not in use must be kept cased until ready to use. Case and uncase firearms only within the assigned booth keeping the muzzle pointed down range **at all times**. No uncased firearms outside of the booth at any time. **Max of 2 guns** on the table only.
- Moving uncased firearms from one booth to another is **NOT** permitted. Exchange positions instead.
- Cross lane shooting is **NOT** permitted; it is extremely **UNSAFE!**
- **No cell phones, food or drink in the range shooting area.** Turn Cell Phones **off**. **NOTE:** This is for **your** health.
- Lanes will be assigned on a per person/per firearm basis. Two or more persons sharing a lane with more than one firearm in **use** is NOT permitted.
- Holsters may only be used by **members** approved to do so by the Chief Instructor or Range Officer.
- Shooters **MUST NOT** step beyond the firing line for any reason. Grab rakes are available to retrieve brass.
- Move target carrier system only with the electric toggle switch, **NOT YOUR HANDS!!!** Use of a standard range target is required. **Not:** target spots on backers, playing cards, empty ammo boxes, clothes pins, colored tape pieces or "hostage" type targets. **No head shots, all shots must be below white backer board.**
- Should a problem develop with your firearm, **Stop Immediately** and inform the Range Officer. **DO NOT BRING** loaded or jammed firearms off the range into the showroom area. This is UNSAFE!
- Unsafe shooting or conduct should be referred to the RO or, Counter Staff immediately!
- **Photographing** (i.e. any form of picture taking) of range area and/or range users is NOT permitted.
